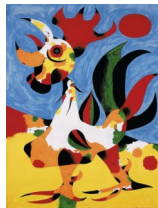

Melyssa for grades 3-6 will meet on **Thursday April 3 at 4:00pm** to discuss the art of Joan Miro. New members welcome. Please register.



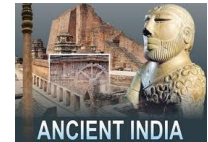

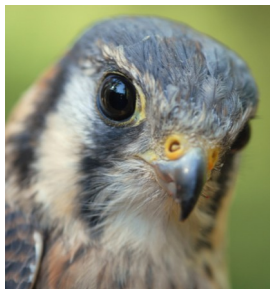
